STOP WASTE BEFORE IT STARTS **& SAVE MONEY**

REDUCE

- Use designs that minimize the amount of materials used (advanced framing techniques).
- Avoid “leftovers”—measure twice and cut once.
- Choose materials that are durable so you don’t have to replace as often.
- Use energy efficient practices and products for construction.

REUSE

- Instead of traditional demolition, consider salvage and deconstruction (taking apart carefully) for reuse.
- Consider remodeling or retrofitting existing buildings for new use.
- Allow time in the schedule for salvage and recycling.
- Use salvaged materials in remodeling or construction.
- Donate surplus materials to non-profits or save for use in the next job.

RECYCLE

- Make someone responsible! Assign a crew member to oversee and take responsibility for job site recycling program.
- Recycling can save you money. Disposal costs at recycling facilities are less than at landfill. Extra costs for sorting at job site are offset by lower disposal costs. Sorting time and costs are reduced as your crews become more familiar with recycling process.
- Clean loads are the key to successful recycling. Be sure that your idea of a “clean load” is the same as your recycler’s.
- Request (or require) subcontractors to source separate and participate in your recycling program and to provide receipts. Provide subcontractors with information on where to recycle materials.
- Early on, set up the site locations for recycling. Color-code or use large signs to help the crew sort materials correctly.

WHY RECYCLE ?

Construction and demolition waste make up a sizable portion of the material that goes to the landfill from the City of Victorville and throughout the State of California. Construction and demolition materials such as concrete, wood, dry-wall, and scrap metal not only CAN be recycled, but beginning in 2011, these materials are required to be recycled, per Victorville and State of California law.

The 2016 California Green Building Standards Code (CALGreen) Sections 4.408 and 5.408 and the City of Victorville Development Code (Title 16, Chapter 5, Article 11) and subsequent updates, **require all building permit applicants to develop and submit a Construction Waste Management Plan (CWMP).** The CWMP outlines how the applicant will achieve a minimum 65% diversion of non-hazardous construction waste from the landfill. In Victorville, construction projects are also required to divert 100% of trees, stumps, rocks, and soils from excavating and land clearing activities.

NOTE: ALL materials hauled to a landfill do NOT count towards the project's 65% diversion requirement. Make sure you know where your materials are going in order to receive the proper diversion credit.

This Guide was created to help Victor Valley builders divert waste from the landfill. Most of the disposal locations listed in the Guide are less expensive than the landfill. Many facilities offer free drop-off, and the scrap metal vendors will even pay you for your scrap metals.

The City of Victorville Recycling Program is available to help you plan and implement a recycling program to meet City and State Building Code requirements, and save you money. If you have any questions, please call the City of Victorville Recycling Program at 760-955-8615.

MIXED WASTE RECYCLING/FRANCHISED HAULER (Option 1 on CWMP)**Victorville Disposal/Burrtec Waste**

Victorville (760) 245-8607

Victorville Disposal offers temporary roll-off containers for large and small construction jobs for mixed waste C & D recycling. Contractor can put all waste from construction site into one box, and hauler will take waste to a high-diversion Material Recovery Facility offering guaranteed recycling diversion of 65% or better with documentation. Sizes range from 10 cubic yard roll offs for heavy materials such as concrete, soil & rocks, up to 40 cubic yards for lighter material. Call for pricing.

Smaller front loader bins (1½, 2, 3, and 4 cubic yards) are also available but cannot give guaranteed diversion or weight receipts for documenting diversion requirements. For Self-Haul (Option #2 on CWMP) see pages 6-18.

PLEASE NOTE: Per CalGreen and the Victorville Municipal Code Section 16-5.11, **contractors must recycle/divert from landfill a minimum of 65% of construction debris.** Contractors must divert 100% of ground clearing debris. Contractors must provide verifiable documentation of diverted percentages

Notice: Solid waste hauling is a franchised operation in the City of Victorville. Builders and contractors may self-haul their own wastes to recycling options. If a builder/contractor is not able to haul its own solid wastes, however, it needs to contract with Victorville Disposal for these services.

Victorville Disposal is the only hauler authorized and permitted to haul solid waste in the City of Victorville.

Builders and contractors working outside the City of Victorville may wish to check with the appropriate municipality to determine authorized haulers for these other communities. Updated 10/2024

ASBESTOS

Any debris generated by the demolition of structures is subject to asbestos clearance prior to disposal. A Certified Asbestos Consultant must certify that the debris is not contaminated, prior to disposal at any San Bernardino County Sanitary Landfills. Drywall can be taken to San Bernardino County's Victorville Landfill for disposal **but won't be recycled or count as needed diversion**. The disposal rate as of Oct 2024 is \$61.49 per ton. City of Victorville **Construction Site Maintenance & Trash Containment** **Requirements**

City of Victorville Development Code, Chapter 5, Article 14, requires trash, rubbish, and/or debris at construction sites to be contained so that there is no accumulation of loose material. Material must be contained in such a way that it will not be scattered by wind or water.

It is the responsibility of the permittee to provide for construction site maintenance and containment of trash, rubbish, and debris and for the proper removal thereof. Material may be contained in either bins (dumpsters), or in a fenced in area of at least 100 cubic feet. Fenced area must be securely staked in place and must be emptied when full.

HAZARDOUS/UNIVERSAL WASTE

Hazardous waste items from businesses such as used oil, paint, pesticides, lamps, cathode ray tubes/glass, aerosol cans, batteries, chemicals and e-waste cannot go in the trash or recycling, as this is illegal in California.

The VSQG program through the San Bernardino County Fire Department will help you dispose of your hazardous waste properly for a reasonable cost, helping you comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations. 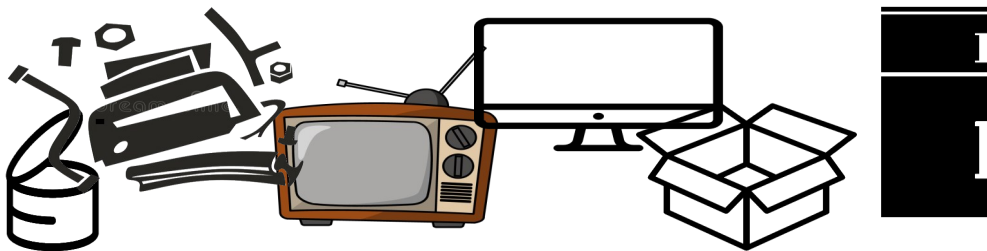

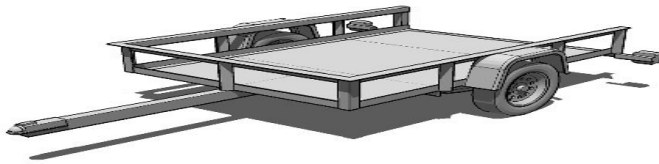
