Greetings from your Victorville Librarian, I hope you all are doing well.

The Library offers free Online Tutoring to K-12 Students and an Adult Learning Center via our partners at <u>Brainfuse</u>. The program allows students to live-help tutoring assistance and other academic support. We are committed to improving the lives and education of Victorville residents, the young and the not so young.

The Library recently went live with Career Online High School, where adult learners who need to complete their High School Education can apply to receive a scholarship to do so. It's a great program, and we already have several applicants taking steps to begin the process.

Starting in January, patrons using our <u>Hoopla</u> platform for e-books, audiobooks, and movies will be able to take advantage of Hoopla Binge. Patrons can check out items under the Hoopla Binge category for seven days with full access to the entire collection of that item. In this way, patrons will expend fewer check-out credits on items in a similar collection.

In other news, the Library recently closed its Request for Proposal for designs on a potential location for a New Library.

The process is underway!

A Library Designer has been hired to study the feasibility of using the building as a library.
