FROM THE FOVL PRESIDENT

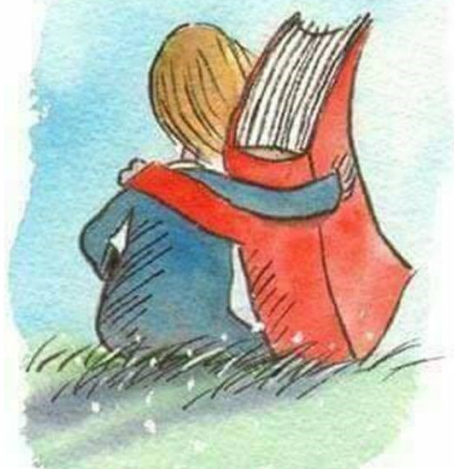
Hello Friends,
