# What Can Go In The Green Waste Bin?

Recycling /composting of garden trimmings (green waste) is good for the environment, AND is **required** per California State Law AB 1826/SB 1383.

**Green waste can no longer go to the trash per California state laws AB 1826/SB 1383**

**See the lists below for what CAN and CANNOT go in the green waste bin.**

*No trash, plastic bags, or other non-organic items can go in the green waste bin.*

Use of the Green Waste bin is for **AUTHORIZED** users **ONLY**.

## YES!

- ✓ Grass clippings
- ✓ Rose prunings
- ✓ Shrub trimmings
- ✓ Tree branches (cut to 4' or less)
- ✓ Weeds
- ✓ Wood chips
- ✓ Flowers



## NO!

**Do not put these items into GREEN WASTE bin.**

- X Plastic bags
- X Paper, glass, plastic, metal
- X Trash or litter, Styrofoam
- X Wood/lumber\*
- X Palm tree fronds or trunk
- X Cactus, yucca
- X Stumps or large logs\*
- X Dirt, rocks, gravel\*



**Put these items in the TRASH**
