



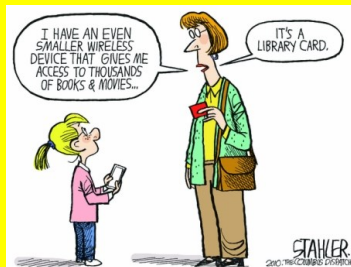
**FROM THE CITY LIBRARIAN'S CORNER**

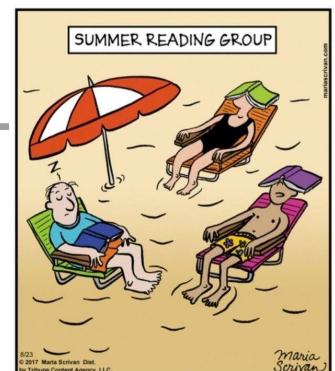

## **New City Library Update**

The official ground-breaking for our new library was held on May 22. Pictured are members of the City Council, City Manager and city staff. Monet Construction, Inc is doing the remodeling and expansion construction of this \$8.6 million + project with completion in late 2025.. With the receipt of a \$9 million grant from the State of California the project is well-funded. Monies from Measure P will also be utilized. Our library will almost double in size to 17,000 plus sq. ft.

The Kiosk will also accept the return of books.

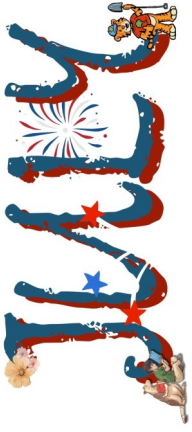
