**CONTEST RULES** - The Contest is limited to City of Victorville residents using cart service. Materials found in the wrong cart will disqualify the residence. Only one entry form per residence. Contestants must be 18 years or older to enter. Winners will be notified by phone and/or email. Entries close on September 3, 2024.

**SORTING REQUIREMENTS** - There must only be bagged food waste & loose yard trimmings in the green organics cart, recyclables in the blue recycle cart, and trash in the black trash cart. No purchase necessary to win.

#### GREEN ORGANICS CART

Bagged food waste such as eggshells, fruit meat, poultry, fish, and bones. Loose yard trimmings such as leaves, grass clippings, tree trimmings, dead flowers, plants, twigs

#### BLUE RECYCLE CART

Office paper, cardboard, clean paper bags, glass bottles & jars, tin & aluminum cans and foil, plastic jars, bottles, tubs & trays labeled #1-#7.





#### BLACK TRASH CART

Plastic bags, diapers, pet waste, hoses, gloves, sponges, soiled cardboard & napkins, straws, film, bubble wrap, snack & candy wrappers and chip bags.

### ORGANICS PROGRAM UPDATE

Victorville's new residential organics program continues to grow! In March 2024, residents diverted nearly 970 tons of garden trimmings and food scraps through the "green cart" program. This works out to over 42 tons per weekday, or about 84,000 pounds per day! City businesses are also doing a fantastic job diverting organics, with 312 tons of wood, food, and garden trimmings sent to the compost facility in March instead of the landfill.





The number of tons of trash from the **City of Victorville** sent to the County landfill in March 2024 **decreased** by almost **1,200 tons** compared to 2023 levels. **Our efforts to separate organics are really making a difference!** 

### WHAT'S NEXT? GET READY FOR "LID LIFTING"!

Beginning in May, the **City** and **Victorville Disposal** will start "lifting lids" to inspect the contents of **green**, **blue**, and **black** carts to ensure proper separation of **organics** and **recyclables** from **trash**.

Tags/notices will be left on carts to let customers know how they are doing with sorting and remind them of "what goes where." Customers who sort correctly will get a "Great job!" rating or a gold tag on their carts, and their address will be entered in a contest for a chance to win a \$100 prize.



The **City** is required by **CA state law SB 1383** to have a "container contamination minimization" program that includes inspections of **trash**, recycle, and organics containers.

Make sure you are using your **blue** (recycle), green (organics), and **black** (trash) carts correctly. ### INFORME SOBRE EL PROGRAMA DE RESIDUOS ORGÁNICOS

¡El nuevo programa de residuos orgánicos residenciales de Victorville sigue creciendo! En marzo de 2024, los residentes desviaron casi 970 toneladas de recortes de jardín y restos de comida a través del programa del "carrito verde". Esto equivale a más de 42 toneladas por día de la semana, o alrededor de 84,000 libras por día. Las empresas de la ciudad también están haciendo un trabajo fantástico en el desvío de residuos orgánicos, con 312 toneladas de madera, residuos de comida y restos de jardín enviados a la planta de compostaje en marzo en lugar de al vertedero.





El número de toneladas de basura de la **Ciudad de Victorville** enviados al vertedero del Condado en marzo de 2024 se **redujo** en casi **1,200 toneladas** en comparación con los niveles de 2023. ¡Nuestros esfuerzos para separar orgánicos realmente están haciendo una diferencia!

### ¿QUÉ VIENE AHORA? ¡PREPÁRATE PARA " EL LEVANTAMIENTO DE LA TAPA"!

A partir de mayo, la ciudad y **Victorville Disposal** comenzará "levantar las tapas" para revisar el contenido de los carros **verdes**, **azules** y **negros** para garantizar la correcta separación de **orgánicos** y **reciclables** de la **basura**.

Etiquetas/avisos se dejarán en los carros para que los clientes sepan cómo van con la separación y recordarles de "lo que va donde". Los clientes que separen correctamente recibirán una calificación de "¡Buen trabajo!" o una etiqueta dorada en sus carros, y su dirección participará en un concurso para la oportunidad de ganar un premio de 100 dólares.



La ciudad tiene la obligación, en virtud de la ley estatal **SB 1383 de California**, de tener un programa de "minimización de la contaminación de contenedores" que incluya inspecciones de los contenedores de **basura**, **reciclaje** y **orgánicos**.
