JOSHUA TREE INSPECTION PROCEDURES

Joshua trees on undeveloped land are protected by City Ordinance No. 1224. Grading a site, removing or damaging Joshua trees prior to completing the following procedures may result in fines and/or penalties for the property owner/developer.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Clearly mark all sites with survey stakes and a visible address.
- 2. Complete an application for Joshua Tree Review (copy attached).
- 3. Attach one set of site plans no larger than 24"x36" with a vicinity map that provides the inspector with clear directions to the subject property(s).
- 4. The site plan must indicate the location, diameter/caliper and height of each Joshua Tree located on the property and those that may be affected on any adjacent properties due to over excavation (sample attached).
- 5. The applicant must indicate the disposition of the trees (i.e., relocation on site, relocation to another property with that property owner's letter of authorization, or place the trees up for adoption). An adoption process may take 60 to 90 days and requires the completion and signature of an owner's permission letter allowing access to the property. The developer/owner is responsible for all associated advertising costs for public notification of tree availability.
- 6. Once you have received a completed inspection report, you may then contact the Building and Safety Department for a grading permit. *You must bring a copy of the completed Joshua Tree Inspection with you.* The grading permit will be issued only when all appropriate paperwork is provided. **No grading** is to occur until the permit has been issued.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

A professional tree mover must relocate those trees larger than 8' in height and 6" in diameter. Joshua Tree background and transplanting information is available upon request. County requirements may apply to trees offered for sale, removed by a professional tree mover or, if the tree will be relocated outside of the City of Victorville. 
