We have been swamped around the library. In case you missed it, we now subscribe to Hoopla, which allows you, our patrons, to Digital e-Books, Audiobooks, Movies, and Comic Books. You can sign up for a free account using your email. Select the Victorville City Library and enter your Library Card Number and Pin. If you need to renew your library or register for a library card, please contact our friendly staff at (760) 245-4222. For more information, visit our Digital Media Page.

Between March 8th - April 17th, kids ages 4 - 12 can participate in our "In-N-Out "Cover to Cover" Reading Program. Parents can register their kids via our Read Square App. Children still learning to read may participate if a parent reads with the child. To participate in the program, each child must fill out a reading log. Each child must read five (5) books at his or her reading level and write the titles on the reading log.

After five (5) books have been read, a parent or guardian will sign the reading log. For every five (5) books read, the child will receive a "Cover to Cover" Club Achievement Award good for a free Hamburger or Cheeseburger at their local In-N-Out Burger. Each child may earn up to three (3) award certificates during the program. While supplies last.

Lastly, we want to remind you that you can order books for curbside pick up. Please call **760-245-4222** to place an order for books or place holds online 24/7.

And don't forget our great Zip Books program, where qualifying books can be delivered directly to your home. If there is a book, e-Book, or Audio Book that you would like to read or listen to during this time, please send a request with the book's title and author zip-books@victorvilleca.gov, and we will try to acquire that resource for you. If it's an e-Book or audiobook, we will add it to our digital collection and let you know once it is available for download. For physical copies of books, we will be able to have a book delivered to your house, and you can return it to the library's dropbox when you're done with the item.
